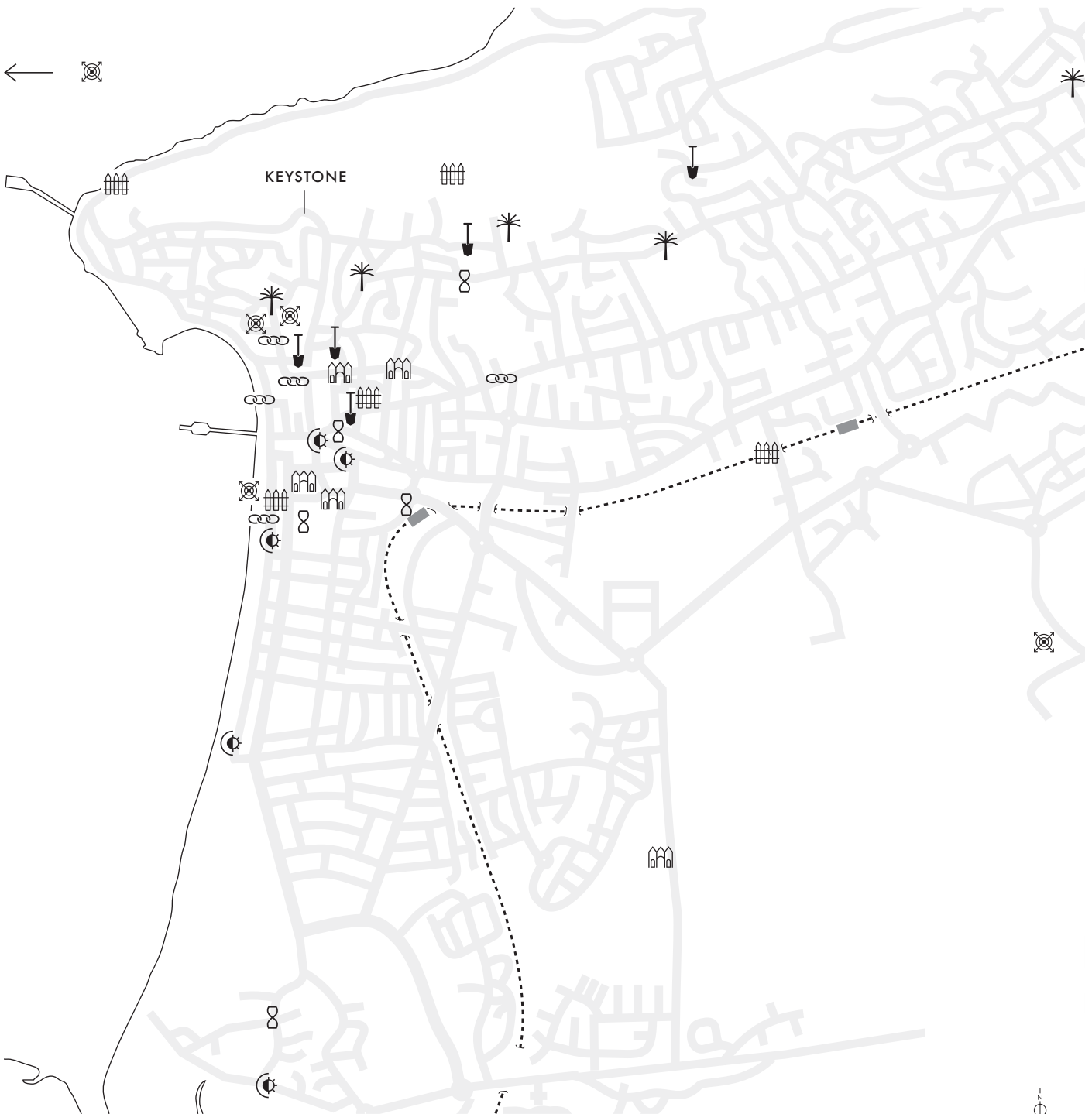


EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO BUILD A TOWN IS HERE

The layers we have identified - THE PANOPTIC, FOUNDATIONS, THE GREAT ARCHITECT, THE AMATEUR BUILDER, THE BOTANICAL, LIGHT, TIME and ANDS - are but a few of the hundreds, maybe thousands, to be found here. You can start your search anywhere, but we have made a Keystone Sign on the wall of the Old Town Quarry where all of our identified layers are exposed.

KEYSTONE

Old Town Quarry. On the South Road wall.



THE PANOPTIC

Sensory Garden, Grove Park. In the flowerbed, at the Lower Church Road end.

Seafront. At the beach steps, to the left of Lorrain's Tea Bar.

Disused Airport. In the Helicopter Museum car park.

Bandstand, Grove Park. On the outside wall of Jill's Garden.

Cardiff. Facing Weston, at the seaward end of the Cardiff Bay Barrage.



FOUNDATIONS

Meadow Street. On the Corner House pub, near the junction with Orchard Street.

Playhouse Theatre. At the front, on the High Street.

51 Cecil Road. On the limestone wall, at pavement level.

Constitutional Club. Opposite, at the junction of Worthy Place and Longton Grove Road.

Naunton Way. At the junction with Ashbury Drive.



THE GREAT ARCHITECT

Weston & Somerset Mercury. To the left of the newspaper's office, on Waterloo Street.

Public Library. At the front, on Boulevard.

Walliscote Primary School. At the front, on Walliscote Road.

Weston Football Club. On the building, just off Winterstoke Road.

Dolphin Square Car Park. On the railings, looking down across the square.



THE AMATEUR BUILDER

North Somerset Museum. Inside the museum, near Alfred 'Juicy Payne's boat'.

The Cliffs Tea Rooms and Gardens. In the gardens, off Upper Kewstoke Road.

Hutton Moor Allotments. On the Hutton Moor Road fence.

Donkey railing. On the sea wall, to the right of the Atlantic Toilets.

Weston Woods. Before the Car Park and water station, on Worlebury Hill Road.



THE BOTANICAL

Lower Church Street. On the garden wall of 39 Oriel Terrace.

Kew Road. On the raised flowerbed, at the junction with Bristol Road Lower.

Far end of Wood Lane. On the green metal fence, as the bridleway heads up to the woods.

Ashcombe Park. Opposite the entrance to Forest Drive, on Upper Bristol Road.

Old Kings Head, The Scaurs. In the pub garden.



LIGHT

Old Church of St Nicholas, Uphill. Near the gate, at the foot of the hill.

Royal Sands Beach Car Park. On the sea wall, at the southern end of Marine Parade.

Grand Atlantic Hotel. Facing the Grand Atlantic Hotel, on the beach side of Marine Parade.

End wall of Alexandra Parade. On the side of Coco's Café.

Odeon Cinema. On the pedestrian island, facing the Odeon.



TIME

Delhi Lounge. At the front, on Alexandra Parade.

Milton Road Cemetery. To the right of the Bristol Road Lower entrance.

Carlton Street Car Park. Near the payment station, at the far end of the car park.

Old Church Road, Uphill. At the junction with New Church Road.

Weston-super-Mare Railway Station. On platform 2, outside the bar.



ANDS

Former School of Arts and Science. Opposite, just inside Lovers Walk.

Winter Gardens. On the sea wall, on the opposite side of Royal Parade.

Atlantic Toilets. At the front, on Marine Parade.

Italian Gardens. Facing the centre of the old wall, on the High Street railing.

Milton Road Cemetery. To the left of the Milton Road entrance.
